1. Introduction:

Odisha Mining Corporation (OMC) has established five “Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalaya (OMAV)” schools (Class VI to XII) in collaboration with Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan (OAVS) in the OMC Mining regions as part of its CSR/Peripheral Development Initiative. The aim of these schools is to provide better educational opportunities to the children in the mining areas by following the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) curriculum framework, examination pattern and assessment. These schools are fully residential and have similar infrastructure and facilities as Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya (OAV), which is a flagship project of the Government of Odisha to offer quality education in English medium to rural students of Odisha at no cost /nominal cost. The OAV project started with 100 schools in 100 blocks in the academic year 2016-17 and now has 315 OAVs & 5 OMAVs operating in the State.

2. Objectives of Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalaya (OMAVs):

- i. To provide access to high-quality school education at village level through these OMAVs, with the goal of all-round development of the children.
- ii. To make a positive intervention in the field of education among the children in OMC mining regions by providing access to quality education and ensure all round development of the students.
- iii. To standardize teaching and learning processes through well-defined manuals and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)
- iv. To promote equal opportunities by providing access to quality education to talented children, largely rural and tribal from different part of the districts, to live and learn and develop their full potential.
- v. To impart general formal education to the children in OMC mining regions.
- vi. Contribute to the development of a safe and secure educational environment for the marginalized children from the mining regions
- vii. To provide adequate and quality infrastructure facilities with ICT to each school covering the remotest areas

3. Intake Capacity:

- i. In each of the classes of OMAV, there will be 2 sections with an intake capacity of 40 students in each section except in Barbil where 4 sections @40 students in each section as per CBSE guideline. The entry point to OMAV will be Class-VI, similar to OAV.
- ii. Students can take admission in an OMAV in class VI and in class VII under existing vacancy through lateral entry. Following CBSE guideline students shall be selected for admission in Class VI and for Class VII under lateral entry under existing vacancy. Details of the locations and periphery village for OMAVs are provided in **Annexure I and VII respectively. List of OMAV existing vacancy for class VII at Annexure – VI.**
- iii. The entry to OMAVs will be done through a common entrance test and other conditions as laid down here under.

4. Eligibility Criteria:

- i. Candidates who are permanent residents of the State of Odisha are eligible for admission to OMAVs. This clause shall be relaxable for the wards of OMC employees.
- ii. Candidates seeking admission in Class-VI to any OMAVs must be **continuing/passed Class- V/continuing class VI** during the academic sessions 2023-24. Minimum age of the candidate seeking admission in Class-VI should be 10 or more than 10 years and 12 or less than 12 years as on 31stMarch 2024.
- iii. Candidate seeking admission in Class-VII to any OMAVs must be **continuing/passed Class-VI/continuing class VII** during the academic sessions 2023-24. Minimum age of the candidate seeking admission in Class-VII should be 11 or more than 11 years and 13 or less than 13 years as on 31st March 2024.
- iv. Students passing out of schools running under State Government/ ICSE/CBSE/ Odia Medium Private Institutions are eligible for taking admission in Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalaya (OMAV) provided that the Institution possesses the status of

Certificate of Recognition (CoR) from the State Government concerned for the class and academic session last studied.

- v. The “OMAV Entrance Test for class VI” is open to the following categories of children: (a) Children who are living in the OMC periphery villages or hamlets (b) Children who are living in the respective block of OMC periphery villages, but not in the periphery villages or hamlets themselves (c) Children of OMC employees who are working in OMC. The candidates must provide valid documents to prove their residence or employment status as per their category.

5. Application Criteria:

- i. A candidate can apply for taking admission in only one OMAV and for only one Class for a given academic year as applicable.
- ii. A candidate is eligible to apply for admission in an OMAV corresponding to his/her native residential OMC periphery villages/ respective block of OMC Periphery villages / Children of OMC employee only.
- iii. Children of OMC employee who are currently working can choose any OMAV they like to apply for.
- iv. Students already continuing their study in any Class and in any OMAV are not eligible to apply.
- v. The child belonging to the periphery villages /respective Block of OMC periphery villages but continuing his/her academic Class as applicable in a school of any block other than the concerned block is eligible to apply, provided he/she has to produce the Residence Certificate.
- vi. To apply for one OMAV and one Category, the candidate must meet the eligibility criteria. The Periphery village students who apply in other category will be assigned to the periphery village category only. Likewise, the Wards of OMC employee students will be assigned to the wards of OMC employee and the respective block of OMC periphery villages will be assigned to the block category only.

6. Categories:

The quota of reservation in OMAVs shall be followed as per the defined categories below:

1. 80% of the total school strength will be reserved for students residing in the designated OMC periphery villages.
2. 10% of the remaining seats will be allocated to the respective blocks of the OMC periphery villages.
3. Rest 10% of seats will be reserved for the wards of OMC employees.

Category wise details of seat allocation are provided at **Annexure II**, list of OMC Periphery villages along with village-wise and caste wise seat allocation is given at **Annexure III**, the list of respective blocks of OMC periphery villages with seat allocation is provided at **Annexure IV** and wards OMC employees seat allocation is provided at Annexure-**Annexure-V**.

7. Conduct of Examination:

Exams will be conducted as per OAVS procedure as provided in the below table:

8. Reservation to be followed for all the Categories:

- I. The quota of reservation in OMAVs will be periphery village and respective block and wards of OMC employee specific. Reservation is based on Gender and social category. The category wise reservation of seats for each social category is thereon annexed at **Annexure – III, IV, V** and VI.

- II. Seats shall be reserved for admission of candidates belonging to SCs and STs as per the percentage of population of the respective categories. Reservation of seats is enclosed at **Annexure – III, IV, V and VI.**
- III. Half (50%) of the available seats in each category are allocated exclusively for girls. Moreover, if there is only one seat left in a category, it will be given to a girl candidate over a boy candidate. This policy aims to create a more inclusive and diverse learning environment for all students.
- IV. In case of non-availability of students in any category, the vacancies shall be transferred as enumerated at TABLE 1.

Vacancies shall be transferred from one category to another in case of non-availability of students as per table given above. This shall be applicable for Classes VI and VII.

V. 4% of the sanctioned seats will be reserved for Persons with Disability (PwD). Persons with disabilities as given below shall be considered for reservation under PwD category.

- a) Blindness & low vision.
- b) Deaf & hard of hearing.
- c) Locomotors disability including Cerebral palsy, leprosy, cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
- d) Autism, Intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.
- e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (c) including deaf-blindness.

One percent each shall be reserved for the persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (a), (b) & (c) and one percent for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (d) & (e) mentioned above.

Persons with 40% and more disability as certified by a competent certified authority appointed under 57(1) of “ Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016” irrespective of nature of disability, shall be eligible for reservation.

Their selection shall be made first and they will occupy most of respective caste category & gender category. To claim reservation one has to produce self certified copy of the certificate during the time of admission.

VI. Admission of students on the recommendation of the Hon’ble MLA/ Hon’ble MP (Lok Sabha)/ Hon’ble MP (Rajya Sabha)/ Collector shall be done as per the OAVS Guidelines. However, it is mandatory that the recommended child should have appeared the Entrance Test of OMAVET to avail the recommendation. The recommendation should be within the time line of OAVs and once the recommendation is accepted, the same shall not be cancelled under any circumstances.

9. Admission Procedure:

- I. Admission to Class VI shall be done in 5 OMAVs opened till date by appearing at OMAVET common entrance test to be conducted at examination centers finalized by B.S.E. Odisha, Cuttack under guidance of OAVS.

- II. For students who want to join OMAVs in Class VII, they have to apply for lateral entry and compete for the available seats. The number of seats as of 15.09.2023 is given in ANNEXURE - VI. However, this number may change over time.
- III. The Board of Secondary Education, Odisha, Cuttack (B.S.E. Odisha,) shall publish advertisement for admission and shall invite applications from the eligible candidates for admission into Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalayas for Class VI and for lateral entry into Class VII.
- IV. The candidate has to apply online in the process intimated by B.S.E. Odisha and specified in the advertisement. If somebody needs support they may download the online application form and shall submit the duly filled application form to the Principal of OMAV where the candidate desires to take admission. The Principal of the OMAV shall submit the details of all applications forms received at their end at the online portal developed by B.S.E. Odisha within the due time.
- V. Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalaya Entrance Test (OMAVET) shall be conducted in the selected venues as notified from time to time. The B.S.E. Odisha shall intimate the candidates registered for OMAVET regarding the date and venue of OMAVET. The entrance test shall be conducted on OMR based answer sheet.
- VI. After the conduct of OMAVET, the answer papers will be collected by B.S.E. officials, evaluate and publish the common merit list and send the common merit list to the DEOs/ Principals concerned for further action at their end.
- VII. After the receipt of the common merit list, the Principal under the supervision of District Education Officer (DEO) of the district shall select candidate as per the reservation of candidate and distribution of seats as at **Annexure - III, IV, V and VI**. The category wise select list and waiting list shall be submitted for approval of the Collector & District Magistrate of the district who acts as the Chairman of OMAVs in the district. The Category wise approved selection list and waiting list shall be published and displayed in the district website, DEO office, BEO office and respective OMAVs. Vacancies existing after the first selection is completed shall be filled up from the approved waiting list of the Collector & District Magistrate.

- VIII. If within the stipulated time for admission, an applicant fails to take admission or fails to produce required documents/ testimonials after proper intimation to the candidate/ parent, his/ her candidature will be cancelled and next phase selection shall take place. The second list shall be published from the approved waiting list after striking off names who failed to take admission within stipulated time of first selection list.
- IX. Students from waiting list shall be admitted till all sanctioned seats are filled up within the due date as stipulated by OAVS.
- X. The Principal of the OMAV shall take steps to admit selected students after duly verifying the documents/ certificates of the selected candidates and maintain “Admission and Withdrawal Register” of the school.
- XI. In case of any dispute in admission, the decision of the Collector & District Magistrate who acts as Chairman of managing committee of OMAVs of the district concerned shall be final.
- XII. The number of seats for each category will depend on the merit (OMAVET) of the students. The students will get the seats according to their preference, availability and reservation rules.
- XIII. For OMC periphery village category: The school-wise periphery village merit list (80% reservation) will be created based on the population percentage of each village and the seats will be distributed accordingly to the different castes within each village. Refer **Annexure III** for more details. If there are any vacant seats, they will be filled by an extended merit list that combines all the periphery villages according to their school.
- XIV. For respective block of the OMC periphery village category, a school-wise merit list (10% reservation) will be created based on the block’s population percentage and the caste distribution within the block. Refer: **Annexure IV** for more details. If there are any vacant seats, an extended merit list will be made by combining all the applicants from the respective blocks of the OMC periphery village category according to their school.

- xv. For wards of OMC employee category: A school wise OMC ward merit list (10% reservation) will be prepared Refer **Annexure-V** for more details. If any seats are left out, extended merit list will be prepared.
- xvi. In case of any unoccupied seats in the Periphery village category after assigning them to the qualified candidates from the respective mining regions, these seats will be allocated to the other respective OMAVs based on the rank list they have prepared using the academic performance of their applicants. The seat allotment will adhere to this rank list in a fair and transparent manner.
- xvii. In case of any further vacant seat in the left out category, the respective linked/OMC-Nodal OAVS (for example, for Rayagada OMAV - Laxmipur OAV, Rourkela OMAV - Lohunipara -OAV, Barbil OMAV- Joda OAV, Suakati OMAV - Banspal OAV and Kalipani OMAV - Sukinda OAV) may admit the eligible students who have taken the Odisha Adarsh Vidyalaya Entrance Test (OAV-Test). The students from the waiting list of the respective block [interested students from the waiting merit list of OAVET residing in the respective block after submitting option form to pursue their study in the concerned OMAV will be given priority].
- xviii. The admission process will ensure that candidates from SCs and STs have a fair representation according to their population share in the periphery villages, respective blocks and wards of OMC employee. This is in accordance with the reservation policy for these categories.

10. Documents to be produced at the time of admission:

- a) Birth Certificate of the student.
- b) Transfer Certificate (TC) from the head of the institution last studied.
- c) Date of Birth/ Student's Name/ Father's Name/ Mother's Name as mentioned in Transfer Certificate (TC) issued in favor of student by School/ Institution/ Vidyalaya last studied shall be treated as final.
- d) Document in support of Social Category (Caste Certificate from competent authority) as filled up during online registration.
- e) Persons with Disability (PWD) certificate from competent authority in support of disability as filled up during online registration.

- f) Residential Certificate from Tahsildar/ Sarpanch/ Councilor in support of Residence as filled up during online registration.
- g) Certificate of Recognition (CoR) in support of institution last studied, if the last studied institution is a Private institution.
- h) Employer certificate of the Parent issued by Head of concerned Institution/ employer, if the candidate intends to avail OMC employee quota.
- i) Residence certificate in favor of OMC employees issued by Head of concerned Institution/ employer.
- j) Aadhar Details of Student, Parent/ guardian.

11. Conduct of Examination

- I. Examination will be conducted at the Venue as released and notified by B.S.E. to the students.
- II. The entrance test would consist of one paper with multiple choice questions.
- III. There will be no negative marking.
- IV. Duration of Examination, language of Question paper, subject to be asked at examination, mark assigned to each subject, no. of questions and total mark with regard to OMAVET is as mentioned at TABLE 2.

- V. The Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidyalaya Entrance Test - 2024 will be conducted at centre selected by the B.S.E. Odisha, Cuttack. Appointment orders to the centre superintendents shall be issued by B.S.E. Odisha who will remain in charge of the conduct of examination. B.S.E. Odisha, shall prepare Descriptive Roll (DR) OMAV wise and upload of admit of registered candidates for appearing at OMAVET - 2024. Candidates shall download their respective admit cards for appearing at OMAVET - 2024. The B.S.E. Odisha shall engage squads at different level to monitor the conduct of entrance examination. Detail guidelines for conduct of OMAVET shall be sent to the examination centre by B.S.E. Odisha, Cuttack. Soon after the examination is over, the superintendent shall seal the OMR answer sheets and other examination materials as instructed by B.S.E. Odisha and handover all materials to the board members.
- VI. The B.S.E. Odisha shall send instruction manual for invigilation work during the examination.

12. Transfer of Student from one OMAV to other OMAV:

- i. No transfer of student between OAV to OMAV and vice versa.
- ii. Student Transfer policy of OMAV shall be done as per OAV student transfer policy.
- iii. The transfer of students shall be permitted within 01 (one) month after the completion of admission process in every year and no such requests shall be entertained after that. The Principals of OMAVs shall not forward the requests of any parents after transfer date is over.
- iv. The transfer of student from one district to another shall be effective only after getting permission from the MD OMC.

13. Lateral Entry in Class-VII:

The vacancies of OMAV in class VII and allow lateral entry for students who want to join. The students must be enrolled in CBSE/ICSE/Odia medium schools that are either government or private but recognized by the State Government. They

must have continuing /passed Class-VI or be continuing class VII in the current academic year. They must follow the OAVs procedure/instruction to apply for admission in class VII OMAV schools. The candidates must either belong to the same block of the OMC periphery village including periphery villages or be children of OMC employees of the corresponding OMAV.

14. Monitoring:

- i. Regular inspections to be conducted by the concerned District Collector/Commissioner/Authorities to OMAVs. Concurrent monitoring shall also be undertaken by the OMC Management and regional CSR officer.
- ii. The progress of the students would be monitored by OMC team from time to time.
- iii. For the purpose of effective monitoring, OMC authorities may itself conduct or undertake field visits to these schools to inspect the progress and performance.
- iv. In case, any students leave the school, after getting admitted it should be brought to the notice of OMC immediately.
- v. All the OMAVs, shall proactively disclose the performance to OMC Management Committee every month in the uniform format as shared by OMC along with photographs.
- vi. All OMAVs shall furnish any information as sought by OMC in a time bound manner.

15. Miscellaneous:

In case of any doubt or in any other matter not provided in the preceding paragraphs, the Centre Superintendent/DEO is empowered to take necessary decision. Other general instructions as issued by OAVS, OMC and OMAV management from time-to-time are to be followed by all the concerned. The instructions contained in this document are subject to change from time-to-time as required.
